Morning English classes

To immerse students in NYC life and culture, our classes take place throughout the city, in Dumbo (Brooklyn), Essex Market (Lower East Side), Brookfield Place (Battery Park), Industry City (Brooklyn) and Bryant Park (Midtown).

Instead of being in a room with 4 walls, the city becomes the students' classroom! The locations have been carefully chosen based on comfort, space, ease of access, points of interest close by, proximity of public restrooms...

Our classes are rich in cultural content and conversation with an added interactive approach to learning English. In addition to completing homework, book assignments, participating in pair work and discussion, just like in a regular classroom setting, students get the added bonus of learning about NYC in truly authentic NYC settings.

Our teachers are qualified, experienced, and use an action-based, communicative method to encourage students to interact and use the language as much as possible. There is a maximum of 8 students per class, grouped together according to level.
